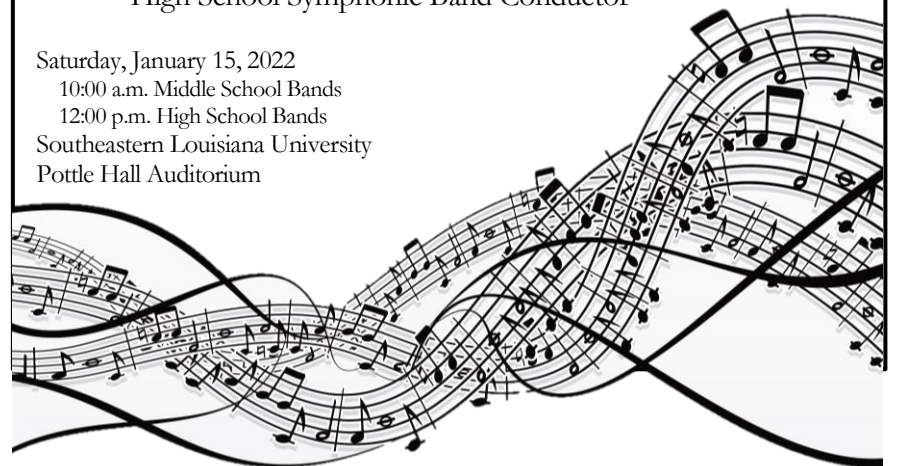

Abby South (BME, Loyola University; MM, LSU) is a second-year PhD student in music education at Louisiana State University. She is minoring in cognitive psychology and has research interests in comprehensive musicianship, teacher mentorship, working memory, and learning theories. Her assistantship duties involve teacher coaching, content development, and community outreach with Kids’ Orchestra Baton Rouge and assisting in undergraduate classes.

Abby has sixteen years of K-12 teaching experience. She was named Band Director of the Year (District VI, LA, 2010), and Teacher of the Year (Juban Parc Junior High, 2015). She is a frequent guest conductor and adjudicator in Louisiana, has presented at the LMEA state conference twice, and has supervised thirteen student teachers from three different universities. Abby was the Honors Ensemble Director with Kids’ Orchestra Baton Rouge (2018-2020) and maintains a small private lessons studio. She is an alumnus of the Glassmen drum and bugle corps, was a teacher of record during her master’s program, served on the board of the Livingston Parish Band Directors’ Association for five years, and is a member of LMEA, NAFME, and Phi Beta Mu. Abby resides in Baton Rouge with her husband, son, and their dog.

Steven Davis is a lauded, versatile, and cosmopolitan conductor who has inspired ensembles around the world. In constant demand as a guest conductor, he has conducted across four continents, working with ensembles in cities such as Bangkok, Beijing, Interlochen, Lisbon, Salzburg, Sydney, Tianjin, Vienna, and regularly conducts in his favorite city, Kansas City.

Davis has worked to break down barriers as a conductor by leading performances across many genres. He has been celebrated as a conductor of wind ensembles, orchestras, opera, ballet, and cutting-edge new music ensembles. In addition to conducting symphonic repertoire of historically significant composers, Davis is fervently committed to performing new repertoire. This commitment has been praised by prominent contemporary composers including Robert Beaser, Chen Yi, John Corigliano, Michael Daugherty, Osvaldo Golijov, Stephen Hartke, James Mobberley, Narong Prangcharoen, Bernard Rands, Paul Rudy, Steven Stucky, Frank Ticheli, and Zhou Long.

Davis currently serves as the Rose Ann Carr Millsap Missouri Distinguished Professor of Music and Professor of Conducting, at the University of Missouri-Kansas City's Conservatory of Music and Dance.

Dr. Myra Rhoden serves as the Director of Bands and Fine Arts Department Chairperson at Fayette County High School in Fayetteville, Georgia. Located approximately twenty miles south of downtown Atlanta, the Fayette County High School Band program has performed at national and international venues and consists of a competitive marching band and winter guards, three concert bands, a jazz band, and several chamber ensembles.

Dr. Rhoden was named the 2018 National Band Director of the Year by the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) and is the founder of the Athena Music and Leadership Camp, a band and orchestra program that was created to empower young women through music. She has been awarded multiple Citations of Excellence from the National Band Association, has been named STAR Teacher at FCHS, was named Teacher of the Year on two occasions, was selected for membership in the Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity, and was presented the 1995 Sallie Mae First Class Teacher Award, a national award given to one teacher in each state for an outstanding first year of teaching. She has been selected to present clinics at The Midwest Clinic, Conn-Selmer Institute, Music for All Summer Symposium, Saskatchewan Music Conference, National Association for Music Education Eastern Division, VanderCook College Music Education Center of America (MECA) Continuing Education Program, Youth Orchestra of LA at the Heart of Los Angeles, conferences for various state Music Educators Associations as well as at universities, school systems, camps, and clinics throughout the country. Dr. Rhoden has had the distinct pleasure of being a guest conductor for The United States Army Field Band of Washington, D. C., the Tara Winds of Atlanta, Georgia, the Sta. Cloud Municipal Band of Minnesota, as well as for numerous state, regional, and university honor ensembles. She is also honored to be a Conn-Selmer Educational Clinician.

Before joining the faculty at Fayette, Dr. Rhoden taught at the middle and high school levels in Alabama. A native of Tuskegee, Alabama, she received the Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts degrees in Music Education from the University of Alabama and the Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of Southern Mississippi. Dr. Rhoden has served as a Georgia Music Educators Association (GMEA) All-State Band Organizer and as the GMEA District VI Band Chairperson. She also serves as a national committee chairperson for the National Band Association, serves on the Board of Directors for the Southeastern United States (SEUS) Honor Band Clinic at Troy University, served on the Board of Directors for the Alabama Bandmasters Association, and is honored to be a clinician and adjudicator throughout the country. She resides in Fayetteville with her husband, Errol Jr., and son, Errol III.

Dr. Simon Holoweiko is the Associate Director of Bands at Louisiana State University, where he conducts the Symphonic Winds, teaches undergraduate conducting and graduate wind literature, guides doctoral students minoring in conducting, and assists with all aspects of the athletic bands. Holoweiko joined the LSU faculty following successful appointments at Michigan State University and Martin County High School in Stuart, Florida.

After serving as Assistant Director of Bands at MSU, where his duties included Associate Director of the Spartan Marching Band, conductor of the Concert Band, Spartan Youth Wind Symphony, and teaching courses in the College of Music, Holoweiko entered the Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA) degree in Wind Conducting at Michigan State University as a student of Dr. Kevin Sedatole. He also holds the Master of Music degree in Wind Conducting from the Schwob School of Music at Columbus State University where he studied with Dr. Jamie L. Nix and assisted with all aspects of the wind program.

Prior to his graduate studies, Holoweiko taught in the Florida public schools as the Director of Bands at Martin County High School (Stuart). At Martin County, he coordinated all aspects of the band program including instruction of the marching band, two concert ensembles, and also founded a curricular jazz band and AP music theory course. He is also the conductor and a co-founder of the Treasure Coast Summer Band Camp in Jensen Beach, FL and is an active clinician. He holds a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Michigan State University.

Holoweiko is an honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi and holds professional membership in the College Band Directors National Association and the National Association for Music Education.
